*Dots: 1 dot for being in the fairway on your drive, 2 dots for a 1 putt, 3 dots for a chip-in or putt-in from off the green.

** Pink Ball – Each player plays their own ball. They alternate the pink ball each hole. The pink ball score counts on all the holes and the best ball of 1 of the other balls counts. If you lose the pink ball, your team is out.
