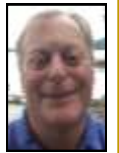

LCC golf news

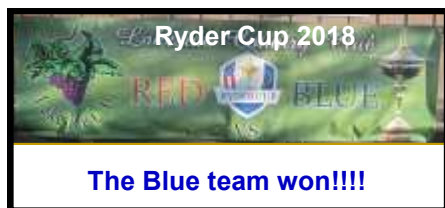


As the season heads into fall, I would like to thank everyone for their continued support again this year. It was a tough April, but it really has been a great summer for golf!
